# Methodology



Results are based on an online and paper survey of 1,009 adults (including 873 in Macon and 136 in Milledgeville) who participated in the Community Foundation of Central Georgia's *On the Table* conversations on October 30, 2019.

The survey field period was October 30 to November 13, 2019.

Throughout this story dashboard, the term "participants" is used to refer to  ${\it On the Table}$  participants who completed the survey.

"Participants of color" self-identify as Hispanic, non-Hispanic African-American or black, Asian, another race, or biracial/multicultural adults.

# Using This Story Dashboard


How much impact do you think people like you can have in making your community a better place to live? n=1,004




